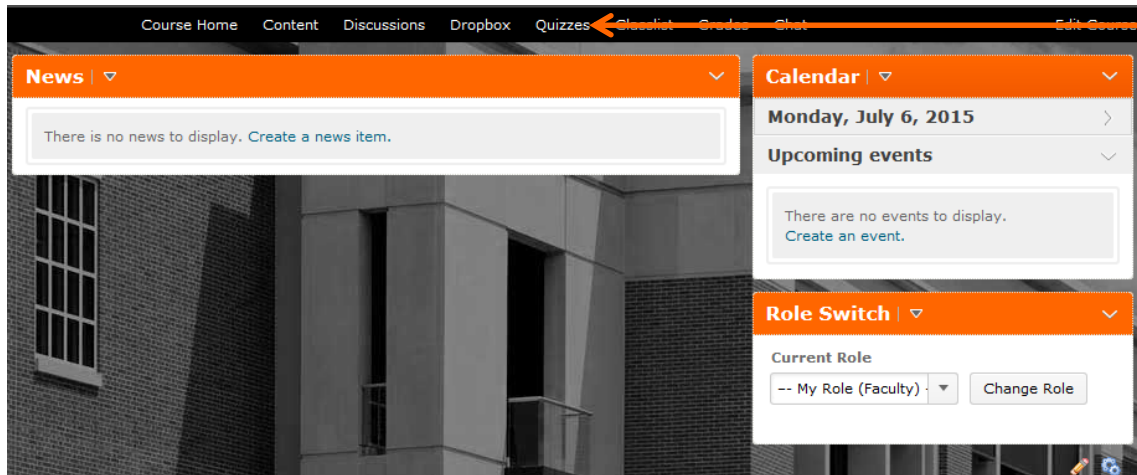




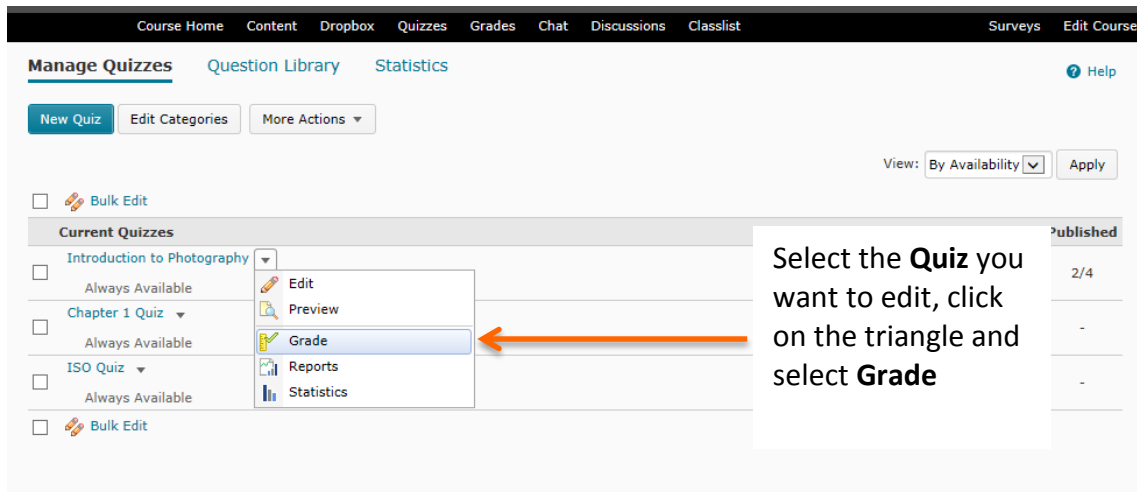
Understanding Quiz Attempts Part 2 in D2L
