





Using assignment groups in Canvas

Assignments can be grouped which can be useful if instructors want to keep their course more organized using categories like Weekly Quizzes, Lab Reports, etc. to keep track of graded work.


Click on Assignments in your course navigation menu. If it is gray, it indicates that no assignments are currently present or that you have manually hidden Assignments from student view.



All assignments are, by default, placed in one single group called "Assignments".



You can change the name of the Assignments group, or any group, by clicking on the three-dot "snowman" icon and choosing Edit.



Enter a new name for the group and click Save.


