

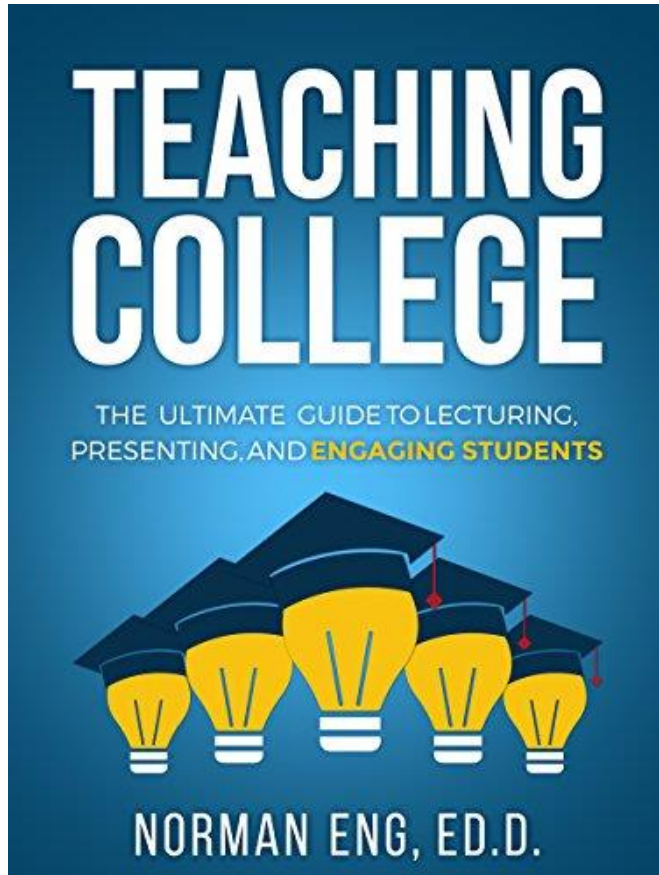


OSU Faculty Reads – Fall 2018
