Setting Correct Answers and Adding Objects

Setting a correct answer and adding a Correct Answer Indicator allows you to give participants a visual confirmation of the correct answer after polling has closed.

- In the Slide Preferences Pane, click to expand Scoring Options
- Select the correct answer from the drop-down menu.



- Click the **Objects** icon from the TurningPoint Cloud ribbon.
- Mouse over Correct Answer Indicator and select the indicator of your choice
